NEW COVID ISOLATION GUIDANCE FOR PUPILS

You have a positive
Lateral Flow – no symptoms:

Isolate for 7 days. If you have a negative Lateral Flow on days 6&7 and no fever you can stop isolation on day 8. Lateral Flows must be taken 24 hours apart. Register your positive result on the Government website.

Household member (someone you live with) has positive Lateral Flow /PCR but yours is negative:

You do not need to isolate but must have negative Lateral Flow each day for 7 days following household member's positive test.

IF YOU
HAVE
COVID
SYMPTOMS:

Isolate, book PCR and isolate for 7 days if positive. Exit isolation after 7 days providing negative Lateral Flow on days 6&7 and no fever. Lateral Flows must be 24 hours apart.
